


PROCEDURE ADOPTED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITEE FOR QUALITY ASSURANCE TO ESTIMATE THE CONTRIBUTION OF EACH DEPARTEMENT

- -Analysis of the population of each department (31 December 2022) and of the SSDs of each researcher (professors and researche rs on permanent and fixed-term contracts);
- -identification by the Executive Committee for quality assurance of the SSDs that characterise each subject (on a scale from 0 to 10);
- -identification of each departiment's level of contribution to each subject according to this scheme::

PREVALENT accounts for at least 50% of the scores related to the university's research staff belonging to the SSDs associated with the subject;

SIGNIFICANT BUT NOT PREVALENT accounts for at least 50% of the scores related to the university's research staff belonging to the SSDs associated with the subject;

MINOR BUT PERTINENT accounts for less than 20% of the scores related to the university's research staff belonging to the SSDs associated with the subject. No mention is given to subjects unrelated to at least 4 research staff. And, the subjects in which the university has not been.
